In addition to the Roma Show Society Rules & Regulations listed at the front of the main schedule, the following will apply to this section.

- 1. All entries must have been photographed by the exhibitor.
- 2. Any person may enter the Open section.
- 3. The Steward or Judge may re-categorise an entry if it is necessary.
- 4. A maximum of five entries per exhibitor in each class.
- 5. All entries are to be clearly marked with name, address, phone number and class on the <u>back</u> of each entry.
- 6. Please include any additional information on the back of the entry to include mode of photography such as 'camera & type', 'type of lens', 'phone', 'drone'.
- 7. All entries <u>must</u> be securely mounted on black *cardboard only* with a maximum 1cm border around the photograph all care given, but no responsibility taken.
- 8. All images must be a minimum of 6 x 8 (inches) or 15.24 x 20.32 (cm) for all classes.
- 9. No titles/captions under photos please
- 10. No same image may be entered into more than one class.
- 11. An entry form must be completed by each entrant.
- 12. Instructions for return, plus postage if needed, must be included with entries.
- 13. Entries from previous Roma Show Photography competitions are excluded.
- 14. If the judge decides that none of the entries are worthy, then no prize will be awarded.
- 15. The judge's decision on place awards is final.
- All entries and prize money can be collected from the pavilion on Show Day Saturday 10th May from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm or Sunday 11th May from 09:00 11:00 am.
 If unable to collect, suitable arrangements must be made with the chief steward.
 After this time, any unclaimed prizes will be dealt with in accordance with legislative requirements.
 At all times, it is the sole responsibility of the winner to collect his or her prize.
- 17. Competitors Declaration All competitors and exhibitors have read and understand the Rules and Regulations and agree to be bound in all respects by these Rules and Regulations.
