In addition to the Roma Show Society Rules & Regulations listed at the front of the main schedule, the following will apply to this section.

1. Exhibits received after 9.00 am, Thursday 8th May 2025, will not be accepted.
2. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor.
3. All classes must be harvested within 12 months of the Show date or otherwise stated.
4. No distinguishing marks to be left on any exhibit.
5. Points are allocated for presentation of entries.
6. Any competitors selling their produce are obliged to donate 20% commission to the Roma Show Society Inc.
7. **The Pavilion will close at 6.00 pm on Saturday 10th May 2025 and entries MUST be collected BY Sunday 11th May 10am inclusive of Prize Money.**
8. No pickled grain to be entered.
9. All prizes and prize money are to be collected from Chief Steward by Sunday, 11th May 2025 (or as per arrangement made directly with the Chief Steward). After this time, any unclaimed prizes will be dealt with in accordance with legislative requirements. responsibility of the winner to collect his or her prize.
10. Competitors Declaration - All competitors and exhibitors have read and understand the Rules and Regulations and agree to be bound in all respects by these Rules and Regulations.
